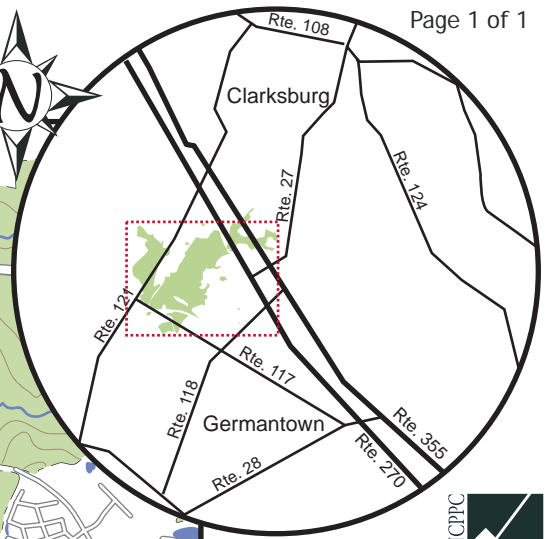


# Black Hill Park Trails

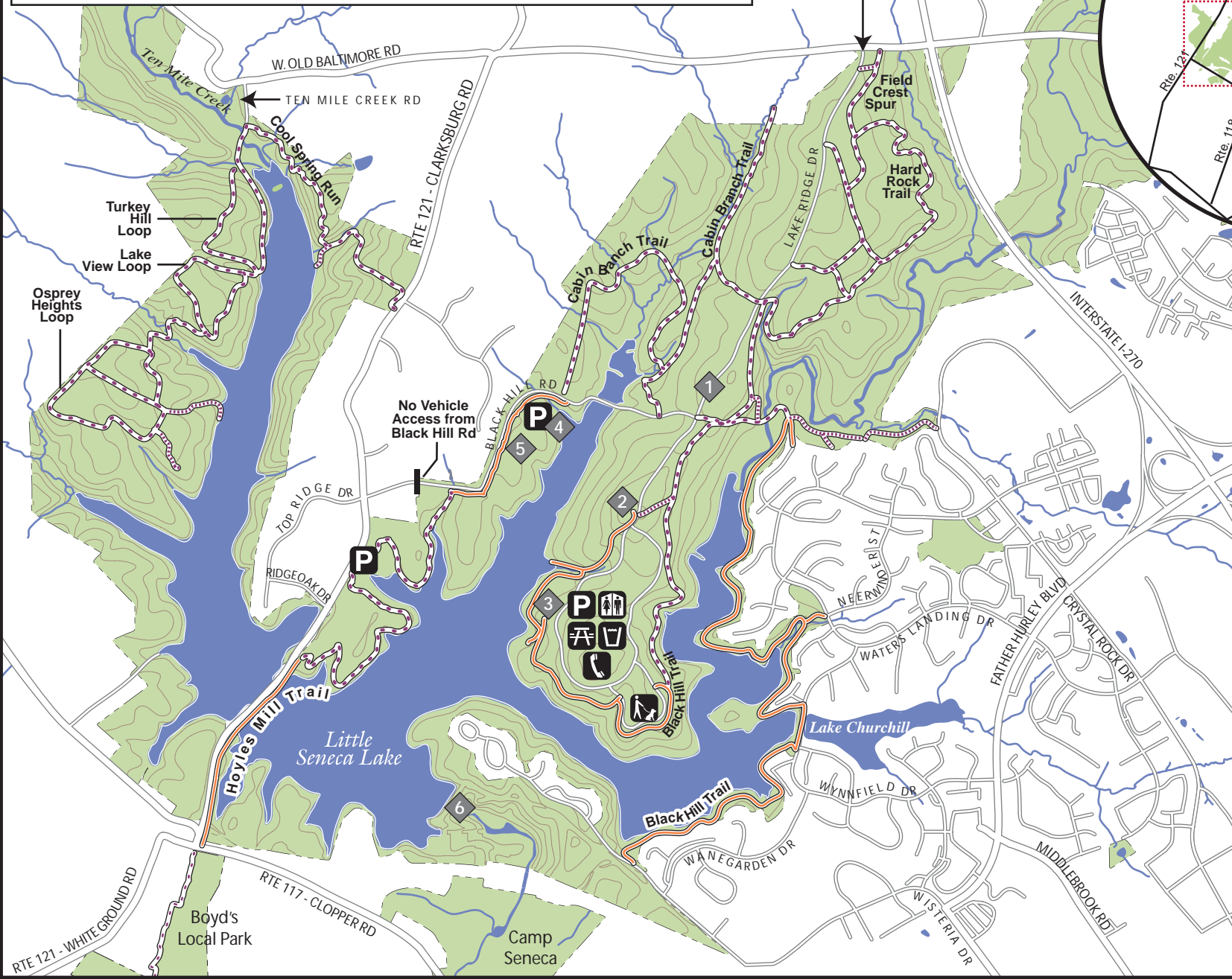
Length: 4.3 miles hard surface trail, 10+ miles of natural surface trails.

The 4.3-mile Black Hill Trail is mostly an asphalt surface, the mid-section of the trail is natural surface and is steep and rocky in sections. The rest of the trails in the park are natural surface. The new Hoyles Mill Trail will take you to South Germantown Rec. Park and on to Seneca State Park.
